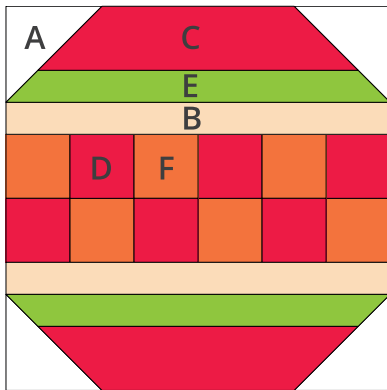


# Block 2

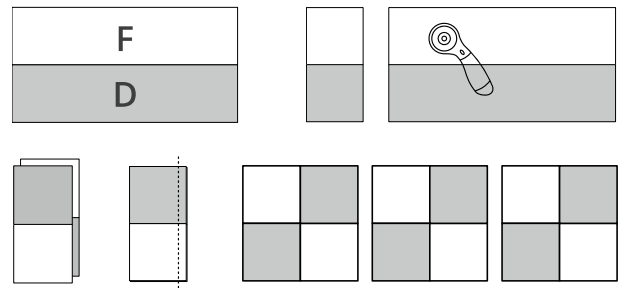
## Wonderful Plaid



	4 x	2" x 2" (A)
	2 x	1" x 6½" (B)
	2 x	1½" x 6½" (C)
	1 x	1½" x 10" (D)
	2 x	1" x 6½" (E)
	1 x	1½" x 10" (F)

All measurements in Inch (")  
 Seam allowance: ¼ Inch  
 Size of the block: 6½" x 6½" (unfinished)

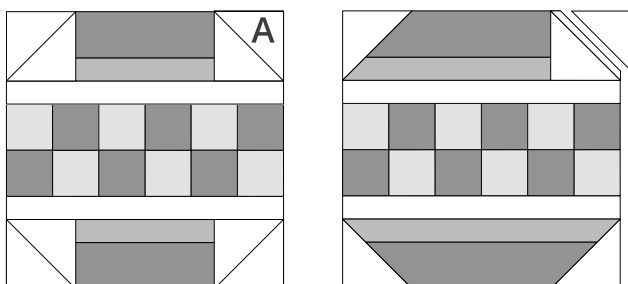
1. Join the **strips D + F** to build a strip set. Cut 6 pieces from the strip, each 1½" wide. Put 2 of the units right sides together. **Fabric D** is placed on **fabric F** as shown in the scheme, the seam allowances are nesting. Sew the two pieces together on the long side. **Repeat twice**, then join the 3 Four Patches to the middle part of the block.



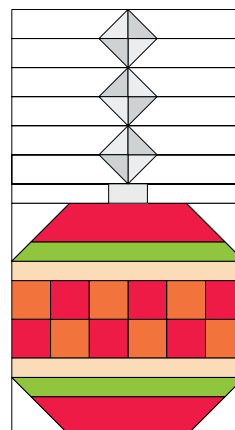
2. Sew a strip set from **rectangles C, E + B. Repeat.**



3. Sew the two strip sets together with the middle part and trim to 6½" x 6½". Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of **square A** and put it on one edge of the block. Sew on the diagonal line, measure ¼" seam allowance and cut away the excess fabric. Press the seam allowances to the outside of the block. **Repeat 3 x.**



4. Join one »Wonderful Chain« block on the »Wonderful Plaid« according to the scheme.
