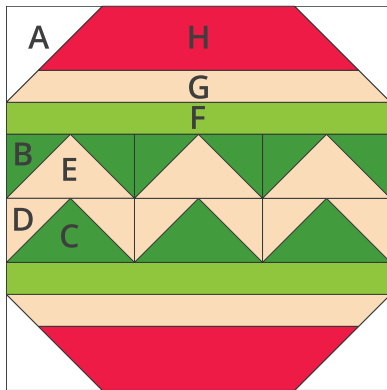







Block 7

Wonderful Zig Zag

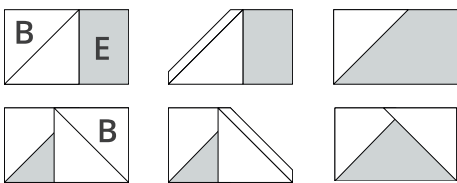


	4 x	2" x 2" (A)
	6 x 3 x	1½" x 1½" (B) 2½" x 1½" (C)
	6 x 3 x 2 x	1½" x 1½" (D) 2½" x 1½" (E) 6½" x 1" (G)
	2 x	6½" x 1" (F)
	2 x	6½" x 1½" (H)

All measurements in Inch (")
Seam allowance: ¼ Inch
Size of the block: 6½" x 6½" (unfinished)

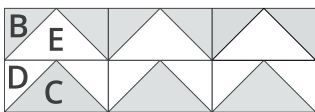
1. Draw a diagonal line of the wrong side of all **squares B + D**.

2. Put one **square B** right sides together on the left side **rectangle E**. Sew on the drawn line and cut away the excess fabric. Press the seam allowance to the outside. Put a second **square B** on the right edge of **rectangle E** and proceed the same way as before. **Repeat 2 x**.



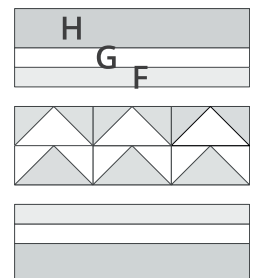
3. Repeat number 2, use the **squares D + rectangles C**.

4. Use the six created flying geese units and put the middle part according the scheme together. Make sure the zigzag pattern becomes visible.

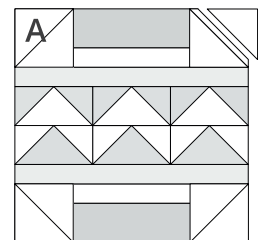


5. Create a strip set from the strips **F + G + H**. **Repeat**.

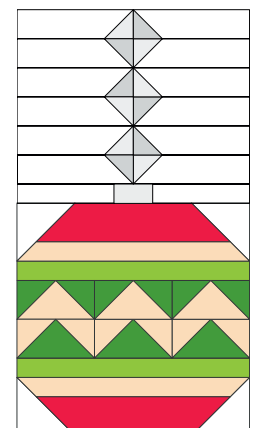
6. Put the middle part and the two strip sets together following the scheme.



7. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of **square A** and put it on one edge of the block. Sew on the diagonal line, measure ¼" seam allowance and cut off the excess fabric. Press the seam allowances to the outside of the block. **Repeat 3 x**.



8. Stitch a »Wonderful Chain« block on the »Wonderful ZigZag« block according to the scheme.
